Thank you for submitting your request for approval of an industry specific. Internet-based training course on bloodborne pathogens and communicable diseases for tattoo artists. The purpose of this review was to determine if the submitted educational materials as well as the methodology for verifying student identification online meet the requirements prescribed in section 381,00775, Florida Statutes and Chapter 64E-28. Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), as the statute mandates that the tattoo artist complete a Department of Health approved blood-borne pathogen and communicable disease educational course.
